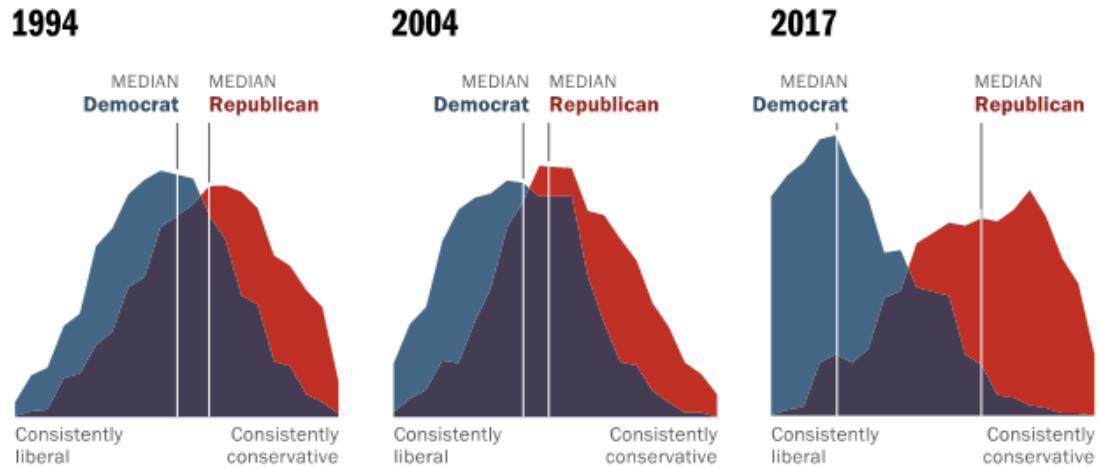

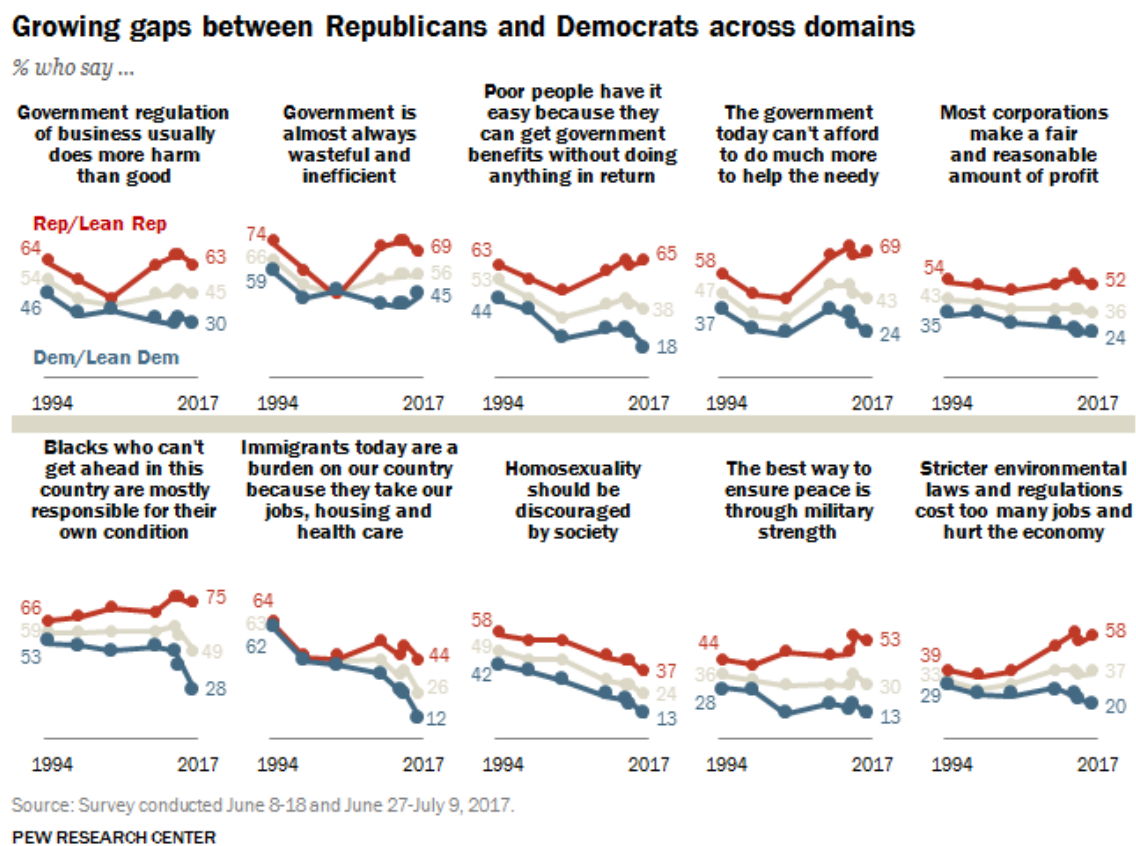

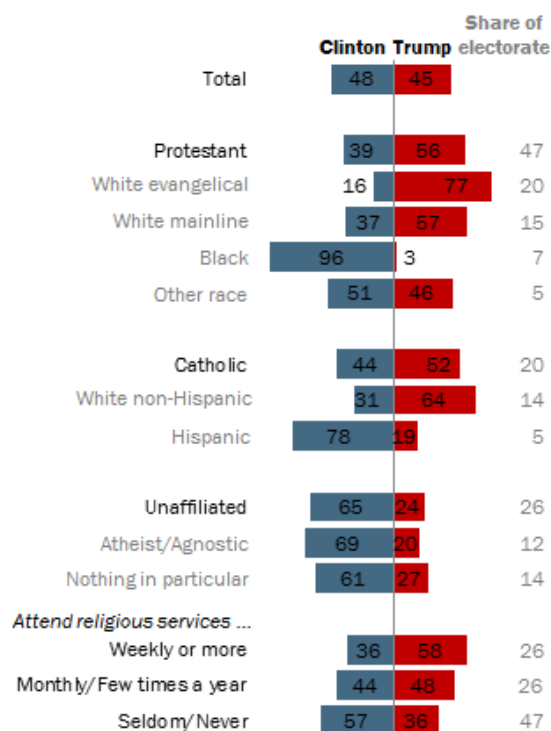

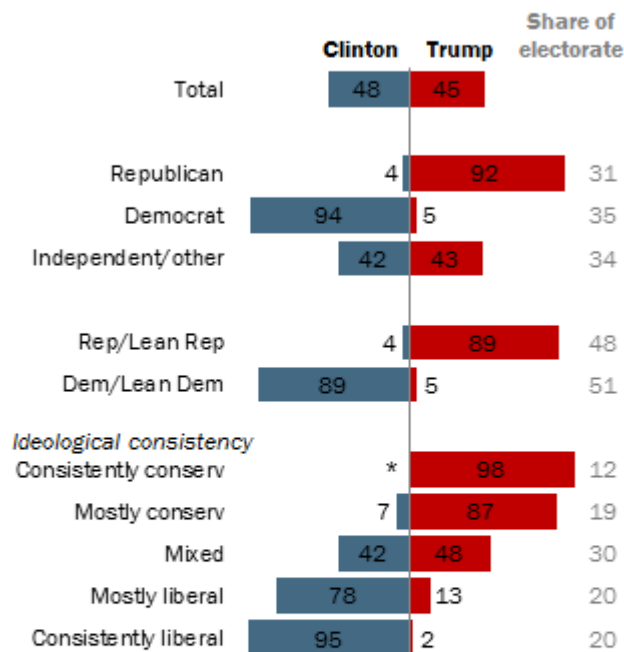

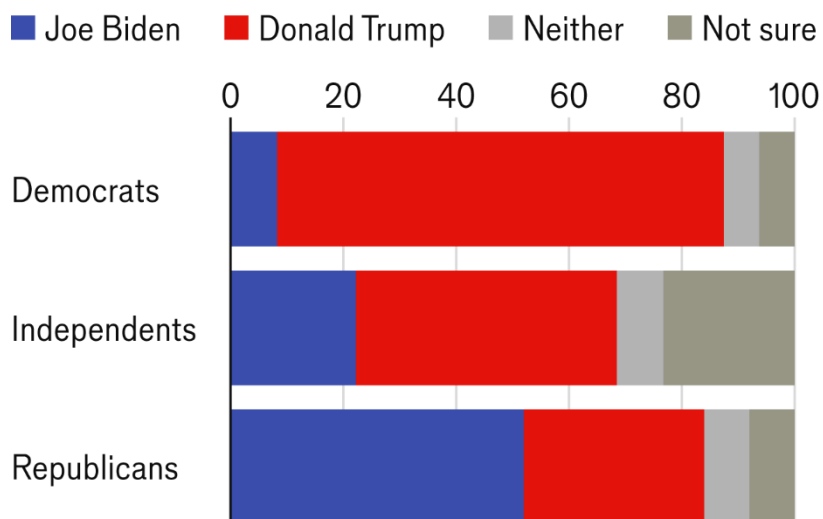

United States, % responding, May 2nd-5th 2025



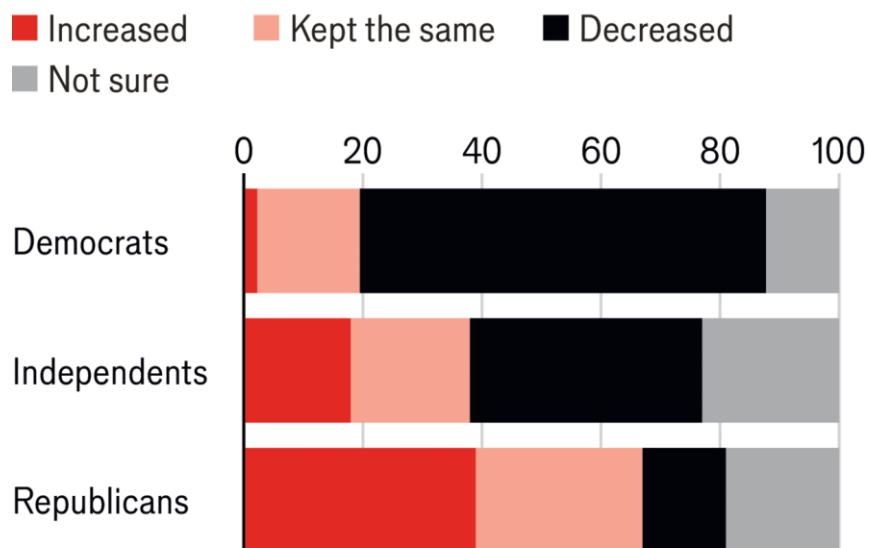
